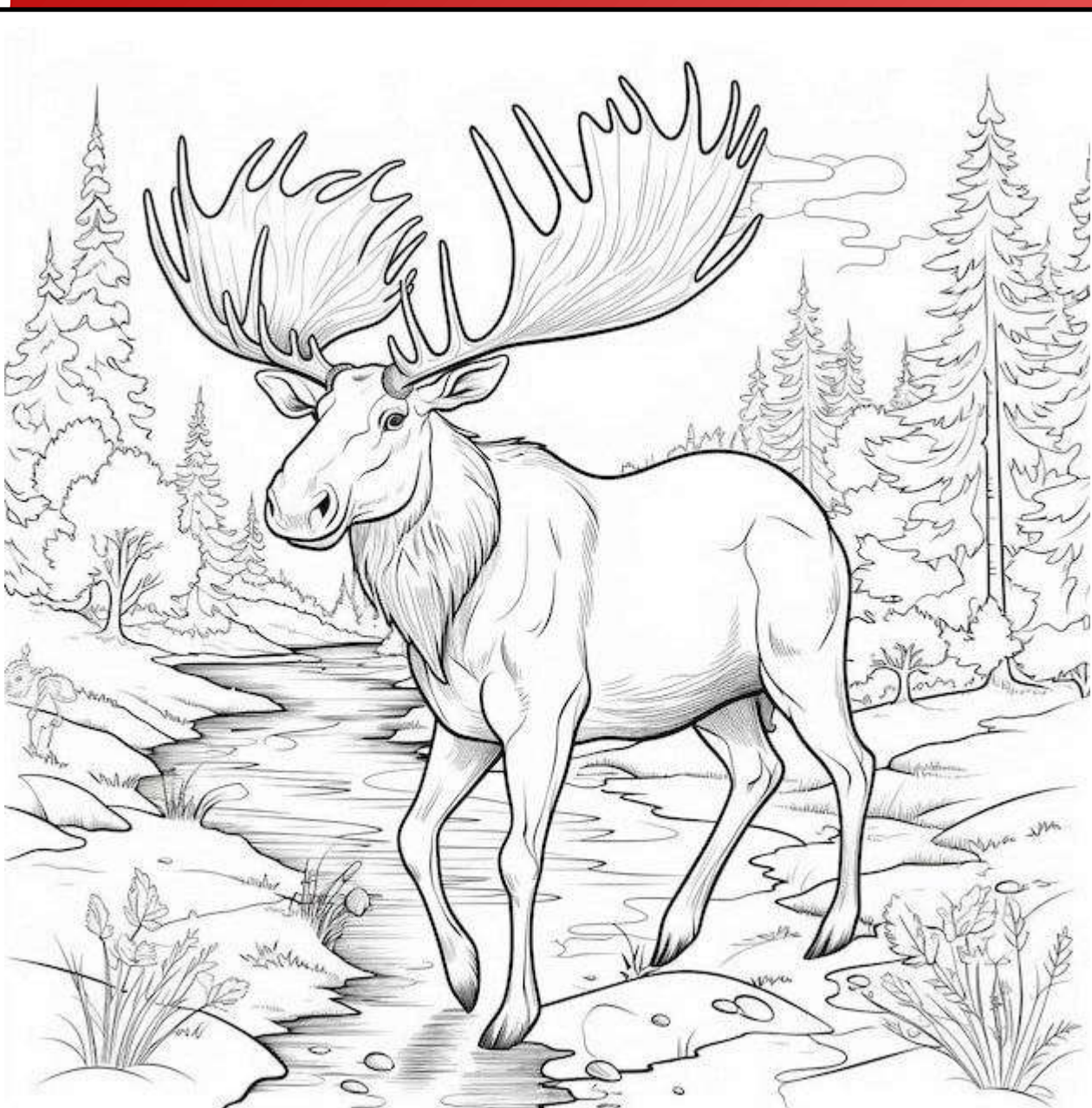

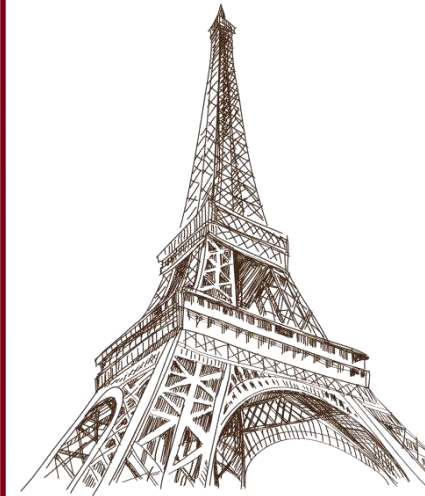

Faits divers «Paris» «Paris» Fun Facts

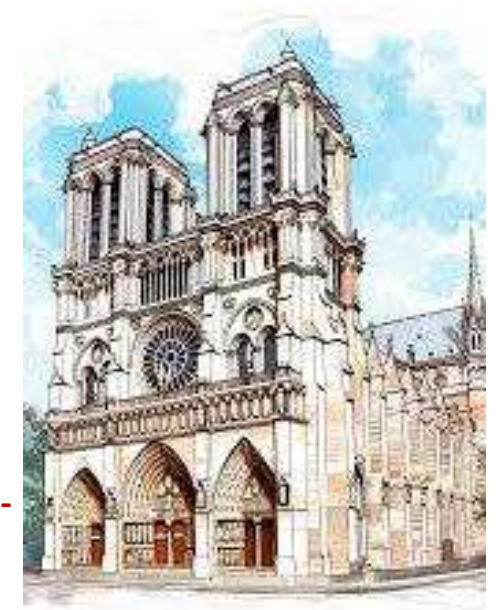


La Tour Eiffel, construite pour l'Exposition Universelle de 1889 et représentant un symbole de la puissance industrielle de la France, devait être détruite après 20 ans. Cependant Gustave Eiffel installa une antenne radio et un émetteur télégraphique au sommet, et le gouvernement décida qu'ils étaient trop utiles pour être détruits.

The Eiffel Tower, built for the Universal Exhibition of 1889 and representing a symbol of France's industrial power, was to be destroyed after 20 years. However Gustave Eiffel installed a radio antenna and telegraph transmitter at the summit, and the government decided they were too useful to destroy.

Le monument le plus visité n'est pas la Tour Eiffel ! C'est vrai que la Tour Eiffel est le monument le plus représentatif de Paris, mais c'est la cathédrale de Notre-Dame qui est la plus visitée. 13 millions de personnes viennent du monde entier pour visiter ce célèbre monument : c'est 30 000 par jour !

The most visited monument is not the Eiffel Tower! It is true that the Eiffel Tower is the most representative monument in Paris, but it is the Notre-Dame Cathedral which is the most visited. 13 million people come from all over the world to visit this famous monument: that's 30,000 per day!
